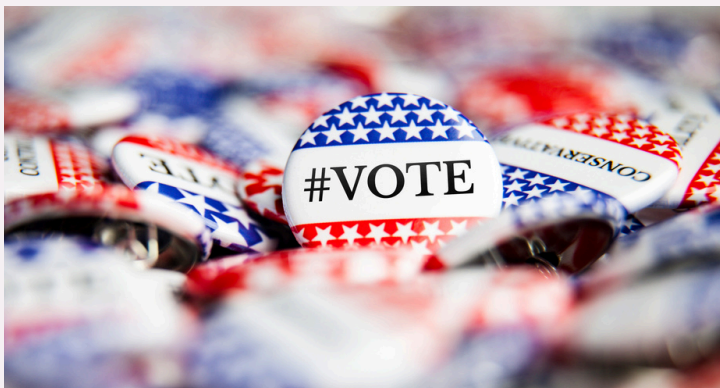

REGISTER TO VOTE

- Last day to register to vote:
October 21, 2024
- If you've changed your name or political affiliation, re-register to vote.
- Complete, sign, and mail the form to:
Registrar of Voters, Division, P.O. Box
611300, San Jose, CA 95161-1300



You can register to vote in California if you are:

- At least 18 years old by Election Day
- A US Citizen
- A California resident
- Not currently serving a state or federal prison term for the conviction of a felony (for more information, please see [Voting Rights: Persons with a Criminal History](#)), and
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court (for more information, please see [Voting Rights: Persons Subject to Conservatorship](#)).

VOTE BY MAIL

- The deadline to request a replacement Vote by Mail ballot by mail is October 29, 2024.
- If you missed the voter registration deadline, you have the option to register through Conditional Voter Registration at the Registrar of Voters' Office or any vote center.
